<b>Focus of visit</b> • SATs	<b>Classes/staff visited: Year 6</b>
<p><b>Summary of activities e.g. talking to staff and pupils, looking at resources, had lunch etc.</b></p> <p>I arrived in school at 8.15am, most of year 6 were in the Learning Curve having breakfast. The atmosphere was happy and excited the pupils were keen to get going with the first SATs test.</p> <p>After breakfast Year 6 went back to their classroom.</p> <p>3 exam rooms were set up, Y6 classroom the Learning curve and the intervention room. I was briefed on the children who would be in each of the rooms. I was also informed of the SATs timetable and the process of opening the exam papers.</p> <p>I did observe Mr Ware the Deputy Head take the first box of papers from the locked cupboard in the head Teachers office. We took the SATs papers to Y6 classroom where Mr Ware opened the package. The papers were distributed to the children who were asked to fill in the front page with their name, the children were also asked not to open the paper until the exam had begun.</p> <p>After the children had been informed of the process i.e. put their hand up if they needed to ask a question, no speaking after the exam had begun etc, the children were asked to make their way to their designated rooms to start the test.</p> <p>I visited all three rooms during the test and all the children were focused on the test paper and were getting on with answering the questions.</p> <p>All the exam rooms had at least 2 members of teaching staff present.</p> <p>The first day of SATs at Austhorpe started very smoothly, was well organised and the children knew exactly what was expected during the test period.</p>
