<b>Objectives of visit:</b> <p><b>1. Get to know your class:</b> The day provided plenty of opportunity to observe lessons, look at writing, listen to reading and experience some of the topic work they have been doing this term. The reading carousel was a particular highlight, the children were engaged, understood and participated with confidence, knowledge and enthusiasm. An Easter themed Design &amp; Technology morning didn't just show the creativity, problem solving skills, collaboration and effective communication amongst the children, it also provided release time for subject leaders and cover for development/curriculum.</p> <p><b>2. Observe behaviour:</b> Behaviour around school appeared to be very good. In the classroom, in the dinner hall, and on the playground children showed respect and courtesy, meeting the schools expectations and adhering to routines. It is a good, friendly and safe place to work and play, with a rare minor misdemeanour being dealt with promptly, appropriately and fairly.</p> <p><b>3. Look at New Heathy Lunchbox Policy:</b> Part of the SIMP was to improve the quality of pack lunches. In the dinner hall it was clear to see that the children were embracing this new initiative. Fruit, veg and a good balance of carbs and dairy were in every lunchbox. Children showed a good understanding of the policy, the why, what and how much, and also seemed to be enjoying their new varied lunches. An approach that should go from strength to strength, create a school of healthy eaters, and provide long-term benefits for all.</p>
